SERVICE DELIVERY

Record

- We built a library to allow our youth and learners access information
- We provided dams and community gardens
- We promoted the culture of self-help and self-reliance to all members of the community
- We established an HIV and AIDS Committee that will directly fight against the spread of the pandemic and ensure the involvement of all wards
- We assisted 32 young people from 16 wards with the acquiring of drivers licences
- We trained and registered 200 youth and women co-operatives
- We built crèches
- We built a sports field at Bhambanana
- Together with the Divine Life Society, we built classrooms in the following schools: Empumelelweni, Namaneni, Ezimbidleni, Mtwazi, Lubhoko, etc
- We provided our women with sewing machines
- We created 20 job opportunities through the Makhathini Cotton project
- We facilitated the construction of a Drop in Centre
- We provided furniture in all community halls
- We assisted in the construction of the Jozini Recycling Centre and thus created 19 job opportunities
- We offered food parcels to poor children
- We helped 1275 indigent families
- We provided 4 milling machines
- We bought 3 tractors to help those who want to till the land
- We build an access road that links Mbhanoyini and Kwashukela
- We tarred all regional roads in Jozini
- We built Ingwavuma Hot Girls, a women's organisation that deals with crafts work
- We created 85 job opportunities for local opportunities
