A Pledge of Honour

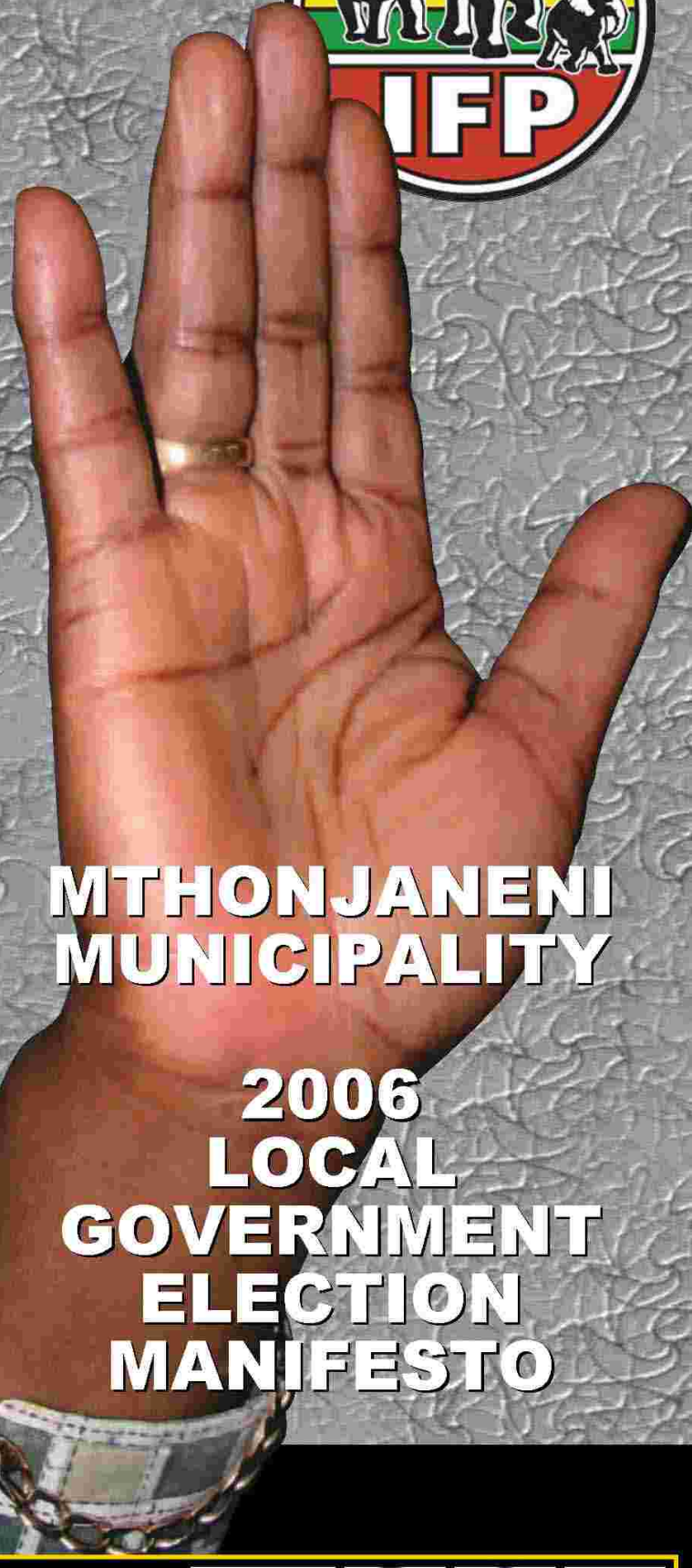
- To remain faithful to this pledge

The IFP led Mthonjaneni Local municipality in conjunction with the Uthungulu District Municipality have successfully delivered the following service to the people:
