## **1** Transport

## 3 Dignified Housing

Trust the IFP for accountability and urgency in housing distribution in Cape Town, and to:

- Prioritise homes for those who have been on RDP waiting lists for years;
- Work towards restructuring of apartheid cities so that people can live close to their places of work;
- Provide low-cost housing on well-situated urban land;
- Prioritise housing for those living in informal settlements, as well as provision of water and power;
- Provision of places of safety for the homeless.

## 4 Job Opportunities

Trust the IFP to get the people of Cape Town to work, and to lobby for more opportunities for the youth and first-time entrants into the job market through:

- Ensuring fair access to government employment opportunities (Expanded Public Works Programme);
- Access to the low-skilled and unskilled job sectors for South Africans;
- Support for women-owned businesses;
- Self-reliance and skills development through youth employment incubators and paid internships.

## 5 Water and Sanitation

Trust the IFP to champion clean, safe, and reliable water and sanitation services in Cape Town by providing:

- Regular maintenance of all water and sanitation infrastructure in all communities;
- More water points in informal settlement communities;
- Ensure water-saving measures are implemented on an ongoing basis.

## 6 Good Governance and Service Delivery

Trust the IFP to change lives in with clean and efficient governance in Cape Town by:

- Resolving irregular billing issues that leave citizens with exorbitant municipal bills;
- Finding innovative solutions to reduce high tariffs for rates, water and electricity;
- Employing people based on skills and experience; no nepotism or favouritism;
- Ensuring regular and efficient refuse removal, and preventing illegal dumping, to keep the streets clean.
